NINETEENTH DAY, FRIDAY, 13th JANUARY, 2023
RACING INCIDENTS
(113-120)

TRACK CONDITION: GOOD GOING

PENETROMETER READING: 3.0 CMS

RAILINGS PLACED AT AN AVERAGE WIDTH OF 3 METRES FROM 1200 METRES TILL THE WINNING POST FROM ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.

1st Race: 113. The Delhi Race Club Trophy - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25 (12 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Jagadeeshan Arunkumar to declare Jockey Shrikant Kamble to ride STAR OF TEXAS in place of Jockey A M Alam who was indisposed and could not fulfill his riding engagements for the day.

Jockey Ramandeep Singh, the rider of AMAZING KITTEN lost his left stirrup as the neck strap snapped , thereby losing considerable ground as the start was affected.

Jockey M.S.Deora, the rider of SUNDAY WARRIOR was fined a sum of Rs 5000/- for shifting in soon after the start when not sufficiently clear causing SWISS AGATTA (C A Brisson) to clip the heels of SUNDAY WARRIOR (M.S.Deora), drop back causing a check to BHAIRAVA'S QUEEN (Ram Nandan Manjhi) who shifted forcing out AMAZING KITTEN (Ramandeep Singh) and thereafter for further shifting out after travelling a few strides forcing out, tightening and causing interference to FAST PLAY (Koshi Kumar) and PRICELESS TREASURE (Sah Farid Ansari).

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that no abnormalities were found on WINDSOR WALK (Gaurav Singh).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner REIGN OF TERROR (Dharshan Antony) .

2nd Race: 114. The Mysore Race Club Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (8 Runners).

Jockey V R Jagadeesh, the rider of CEDAR WOOD was fined a sum of Rs 2000/- for shifting in 50 metres after the start causing MARANELLO (R Manish) to be checked to avoid clipping the heels of CEDAR WOOD. The Club's Veterinary Officer when asked to examine the horse reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

ANGAVAI (Dharshan Antony) drifted wide out in the final stages of the race under pressure. Trainer Mr.K.S.Mandanna was informed to take remedial measures before next accepting with his charge.

Jockey M.S.Deora, the rider of STAR LAP was severely cautioned for trying to take a gap where there wasn't one passing the 900 metres inconveniencing PRICELESS BEAUTY (S.A.Amit).

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that STAR LAP (M.S.Deora) had sustained superficial injury on left fore cannon.

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that PRICELESS BEAUTY (S.A.Amit) had lost her Right fore shoe during the race.

Jockey Sah Farid Ansari, the rider of MUSANDA was fined a sum of Rs 5000/- for shifting in soon after the start causing interference to STAR LAP (M.S.Deora) whose rider was unbalanced and lost his stirrups which he regained after travelling a few strides. The Club's Veterinary Officer when asked to examine MUSANDA (Sah Farid Ansari) reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ANGAVAI (Dharshan Antony).

3rd Race: 115. The A.M.K.M.AL.Muthukaruppan Chettiar Memorial Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. For Maiden Horses 3 Years old only (10 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer R.Foley to deputise on behalf of Trainer Neil Darashah for TRUE FAITH (S Zervan) at both trainer's risk and liability.

Trainer R.Foley was fined a sum of Rs 2000/- for his charge ROYAL SUPREMACY (Sah Farid Ansari) reaching late to the paddock and thereafter led late to the starting gate, delaying proceedings.

SMASH SHOT (G Manikandan) veered out after the start and thereafter was hanging out for major part of the race, ran detached and took no practical part in the race. Trainer Dr.Anil Kumar was informed not to accept with his charge until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in 2 mock races on the race track on a race day. The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of LARADO reported that his mount was running green.

Jockey S Zervan, the rider of TRUE FAITH reported that his mount was running green.

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that TRUE FAITH (S Zervan) had lost right hind shoe during the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner TRUE FAITH (S Zervan).

4th Race: 116. The Turf Authorities Trophy - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (8 Runners).

KAY STAR (Neeraj Rawal) was hanging in throughout the straight, despite jockey's efforts. The Club's Veterinary Officer when asked to examine the gelding reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

Jockey Shamaz Shareef, the rider of INDIAN PATRIOT was fined a sum of Rs.5000/- for shifting in sharply passing the 900 metres when not sufficiently clear causing CONSTANT VARIABLE (Dashrath Singh) to be checked, stumble and drop back by 3 to 4 lengths.

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that no abnormalities were found on KARADENIZ (Shrikant Kamble).

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that INDIAN PATRIOT (Shamaz Shareef) had sustained superficial injury on left gaskin.

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that GLORIOUS DESTINY (Ram Nandan Manjhi) was observed to have sharp molars in the mouth.

An Enquiry has been opened into the running and riding of GLORIOUS DESTINY ridden by Jockey Ram Nandan Manjhi and trained by Fazal-Ul-Rehman.

An Enquiry has been opened into the running and riding of INDIAN PATRIOT ridden by Jockey Shamaz Shareef and trained by Rakesh.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner WIND SYMBOL (Yash Narredu).

5th Race: 117. The Madras Race Club Auction Sale Million - (About) 1200 metres. For Maiden Horses 3 Years old only (7 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer Saddam Iqbal to declare Jockey S.Saqlain to ride PERFECT BLEND in place of Jockey Ashhad Asbar who was indisposed and could not fulfill his riding engagements for the day.

PERFECT BLEND (S.Saqlain) jumped awkwardly losing a length.

SAMURAI BLUE (Neeraj Rawal) was observed to be running out throughout the race. Trainer James Mckeown was advised to take remedial measures before next accepting with his charge. The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that the colt was found to have bit sore on Right commisure.

RUN HAPPY RUN (Dashrath Singh) dropped back in the final stages of the race and ran green.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner SAIGON (Imran Chisty) .

6th Race: 118. The Turf Authorities Trophy - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (8 Runners).

EMPRESS ETERNAL (Sah Farid Ansari) was slow to start losing about 2 lengths.

SANTA CLARA (Dashrath Singh) jumped awkwardly outwards, and thereafter gradually dropped back entering the straight. The Club's Veterinary Officer when asked to examine the mare reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner STAR ROMANCE (Yash Narredu).

7th Race: 119. The WOLF 777 Madras Race Club Commemoration 246th Year Trophy - (About) 2000 metres. A Handicap for Horses rated 60 to 85 (40 to 59 Eligible) (6 Runners).

The Starter reported that the electronic trigger did not function when effected the start in that situation a manual start was affected.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner GOLDEN KINGDOM (P.S.Kaviraj).

8th Race: 120. The Royal Western India Turf Club Trophy - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (9 Runners).

Permission was granted to Trainer J.Sebastian to declare Jockey P.S.Kaviraj, to ride MR KOOL in place of Jockey Imran Chisty who was indisposed.

ARTHUR (Yash Narredu) was slow to start as the start was affected.

HEBRON (Ram Nandan Manjhi) Starting Stall Certificate revoked.

Trainer Deepesh Narredu was fined a sum of Rs 2000/- as CORUS (S.Imran) was not sporting a tongue strap in the paddock, subsequently it was put on before the gelding left the paddock.

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that ALBINUS (Neeraj Rawal) had sustained superficial injury on both hind cannon.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ALBINUS (Neeraj Rawal) .

SMASH SHOT (G Manikandan) Jumped and veered out. SSC revoked. Advised two gates and two mock races.

4th Race: 116. The Turf Authorities Trophy - Div. I (About) 1200 Metres

INDIAN PATRIOT (Shamaz Shareef) and KAY STAR (Neeraj Rawal) Jumped awkwardly.

5th Race: 117. The Madras Race Club Auction Sale Million (About) 1200 Metres

ASIO (Yash Narredu) and FLORENCE (P.Sai Kumar) Jumped awkwardly.

PERFECT BLEND (S.Saqlain) Fly jumped awkwardly.

6th Race: 118. The Turf Authorities Trophy - Div. II (About) 1200 Metres

SANTA CLARA (Dashrath Singh) and CARTEL (Dharshan Antony) Jumped awkwardly.

GOLDEN MARINA (S.Saqlain) Fly jumped awkwardly.

7th Race: 119. The WOLF 777 Madras Race Club Commemoration 246th Year Trophy (About) 2000 Metres

Due to technical issues, the race was started manually.

SUCCESSFUL (S.A.Amit) Lost about 3-4 lengths.

8th Race: 120. The Royal Western India Turf Club Trophy (About) 1600 Metres

ARTHUR (Yash Narredu) Jumped awkwardly.

HEBRON (Ram Nandan Manjhi) Veered out. SSC revoked.
