(151-158)

TRACK CONDITION: CLOUDY DAY
PENETROMETER READING: 3.00 CMS
RAILINGS POSITION: RAILINGS ARE PLACED AT AN AVERAGE WIDTH OF 5.00 METRES FROM 1200 MTRS TILL THE WINNING POST, FROM ITS ORIGINAL POSITION.

1st Race: 151. The Air Force Trophy - Div. II - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 6 years old and over (8 Runners).

Jockey S Kabdhar, the rider of OFF SHORE BREEZE was fined Rs 5000/-for riding an injudicious race.

Explanation of Jockey's Kabdhar (**OFF SHORE BREEZE**) that his instructions were to 2nd / 3rd and do his best when shown the replay of the race for his efforts in positioning his horse in forward position he stated his horse could not keep up pace thereafter he did his best was not accepted and the Jockey was fined Rs. 5,000/- for tender handling of his mount. The Jockey was further cautioned to be more careful in future failing which he will be liable for severe disciplinary action.

Trainer J Sebastian was called and asked for his explanation of his mount **OFFSHORE BREEZE** he informed that his jockey informed him his charge wasn't able to keep up the pace and stated it was wrong distance for his horse when questioned why did he run in that case he stated there was no distance race in his favour to run further than that he did not have a plausible answer and opined that he will run his charge that suit his charge it was noted he was also asked to be more careful in running of his charges

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner DANNY'S GIRL (M.S.Deora).

2nd Race: 152. The S.Parthasarathy Memorial Trophy - (About) 1200 metres. For Maiden Horses 3 Years Old Only (7 Runners).

The Club's Veterinary Officer was asked to examine ETHICAL (Ram Nandan Manjhi) who reported after the race that no abnormalities were found.

Jockey Ram Nandan Manjhi, the rider of ETHICAL reported that his filly did not raise a fluent gallop through out the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner SET IN GOLD (Mukesh Kumar (Hyd)).

3rd Race: 153. The Army Trophy - (About) 1600 metres. Horses rated 60 to 85 (9 Runners).

WIND SYMBOL (Inayat) drifted out in the final 200 metres taking out BRILLIANT LADY (A S .Peter) who was squeezed in between RAYS OF SUN (Ram Nandan Manjhi).

The Club's Veterinary Officer reported after the race that no abnormalities were found in ROYAL DEFENDER (Kuldeep Singh).

Explanation of Jockey Kuldeep Singh (ROYAL DEFENDER) that his mount did not raise a fluent gallop throughout the race in spite of his efforts also stated he didn't get a opening in the straight . Explanation noted.

Trainer J Sebastian advised for a better performance in future.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner SCHNELL (Mukesh Kumar (Hyd)).

4th Race: 154. The Navy Trophy - Div. I - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (12 Runners).

ILLUSTRIOUS RULER (App Darshan.N)_reared up as the start was affected

Jockey C Umesh, the rider of GREY BEAUTY reported his horse was hanging in.

Jockey C A Brisson, the rider of CARTEL reported loss of whip near the 300 metres marker.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner GREY BEAUTY (C Umesh).

5th Race: 155. The Air Force Trophy - Div. I - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 40 to 65, 6 years old and over (8 Runners).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner SONIC DASH (Sah Farid Ansari).

6th Race: 156. The O.T.A Trophy - (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (9 Runners).

SILVER SOUL (Ram Nandan Manjhi) slowly away, jumped and veered out.

SENSATIONS (P.Vikram) planted and took no practical part in the race.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner CHARUKALA (Hindu Singh).

7th Race: 157. The Police Trophy - (About) 1100 metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 6 years old and over (Whips not allowed) (11 Runners).

MARSHALL (Hindu Singh) was presented with the wrong saddle number and was permitted to be withdrawn before coming under starter's order.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner SACRE COUER (Darshan.N).

8th Race: 158. The Navy Trophy - Div. II - (About) 1200 metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over (12 Runners).

Jockey C Umesh, the rider of PRESTO POWER reported loss of whip near 150 metres.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from AUTHENTIC BELL (M.S.Deora) and KALYANI MUSLR (P.Vikram).

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner ANGAVAI (Hindu Singh).

1st Race: 151. The Air Force Trophy - Div. II (About) 1100 Metres

IMPIANA (C Umesh) Lost about a length at the start,

2nd Race: 152. The S.Parthasarathy Memorial Trophy (About) 1200 Metres

ETHICAL (Ram Nandan Manjhi) Jumped out towards inside and lost about a length at the start.

3rd Race: 153. The Army Trophy (About) 1600 Metres

RAYS OF SUN (Ram Nandan Manjhi) Lost about 1/2 length at the start.

4th Race: 154. The Navy Trophy - Div. I (About) 1200 Metres

ILLUSTRIOUS RULER (Darshan.N) Reared up when start effected and lost about 5 lengths at the start.

5th Race: 155. The Air Force Trophy - Div. I (About) 1100 Metres

SPECTACLE (Shankar Lal H) Lost about a length at the start

RAFFINATO (C Umesh) Lost about 2 lengths at the start.

6th Race: 156. The O.T.A Trophy (About) 1400 Metres

SILVER SOUL (Ram Nandan Manjhi) Lost about 3 lengths at the start.

VELLAIAMMA (Dharshan Antony) Lost about a length at the start.

SENSATIONS (P.Vikram) Planted at the gates after jumping out lost about distance. SSC revoked advised 2 gate pratice and 1 Mock race.

ANGAVAI (Hindu Singh) Took a fly jump at the start

KALYANI MUSLR (P.Vikram) Lost about 2 lengths at the start

Enquiry into the wrong saddle cloth number on horses trained by Ajith Kumar in race no 157 The Police Trophy (MARSHALL)and Saddle, incorrectly in race no 158 The Navy trophy (Div II)

The stewards of the Club at their meeting held after the last race questioned Trainer Ajith Kumar who was asked for his explanation. Briefing the Stewards, Chief Stipendiary Steward explained Trainer Ajit Kumar had three runners in

(ie **THE POLICE TROPHY race no 157**) MARSHALL trained by him should carry saddle cloth no 12, instead the horse reached the starting stall with the saddle cloth no 11.

The Chief Stipendiary Steward found there were two horses with the same saddle cloth numbers subsequently MARSHALL (Hindu Singh was withdrawn before coming under starters orders.

In the next race i.e **The Navy Trophy (Div II)** Trainer Ajit Kumar had two runners (AUTHENTIC BELL and KALYANI MUSLR) had been saddled with the wrong number cloths being worn and the horses were paraded in the paddock. On observation Trainer was asked to resaddle after weighing out by the respective jockeys. (P.Vikram KALYANI MUSLR and M S Deora AUTHENTIC BELL).

The Stewards at their meeting deliberated, the saddling of the horses for a race is the responsibility of the trainer and sheer negligence on his part was not acceptable the trainer stated since he had two runners and did not have enough staff to support him during saddling the error occurred and in the previous race ie race no 157 he had three runners and saddle came in late the Stewards took grave ambrage he being A licensed and he is vicarious responsible as a Trainer .

Trainer Ajit Kumar was apologetic for his grave mistake .After deliberating on the matter and in conjunction with Chief Stipendiary Steward also in race no 157 MARSHALL was withdrawn before coming under starter's order and in race no 158 both horses (AUTHENTIC BELL and KALYANI MUSLR) ran the race duly carried the correct saddle.

The Stewards in their decision decided that it is the duty of the Trainer and he is responsible as a trainer for saddling, saddle cloth numbers, after hearing his submissions and not being satisfied with the explanation tendered by Trainer Ajit Kumar Stewards fined Trainer Ajit Kumar a sum of **Rs 25,000/ each (race no 157)and (race no 158)** for his lapse and held him responsible and in future to be very cautious in the duties as "A" licence Trainer.

ADDITIONAL REPORT

THE STEWARDS ENQUIRY - THE SHA TIN HANDICAP DIV I - Wednesday , 1/1/25

The Stewards of the Club noted that shortly before the start was affected, SUNNY ISLES (Kuldeep Singh drawn 9) the handler did not remove the blindfold resulting in SUNNY ISLES Jumping out awkwardly with the blinds got unbalanced and dislodged the rider.

At the behest of the Stewards an enquiry was conducted immediately after running of the race. The Starters were called to explain the incident and after deliberation the Stewards of the Club decided to declare SUNNY ISLES as a **NON-STARTER** and advised to return all the investments made on SUNNY ISLES in that race.
